We do understand that it won't be possible for all the students to be on-campus as some of them are out of town and attending the online classes. Hence, the school will be holding hybrid sessions for these students who will be preferring to attend virtual school. Please make a note of the following important points:

1. Hybrid/on-campus classes will start from **Monday, November 22, 2021.**
2. To ensure smooth functioning of virtual and on campus sessions, we are planning to call each grade only once/twice a week. The schedule for different grades is listed below:

3. Arrival and Dispersal Protocol

- a) Students who have opted for on campus classes to report to school as per the timings mentioned in the table above.
- b) Students to be in their proper school uniform/house uniform.
- c) **Students to carry their own snacks (2 meal boxes), water bottle and sanitizers. No sharing of meals will be allowed.**
- d) Thermal screening will be done at both the gates.
- e) Students will be assembling at the Amphitheatre. They will be escorted to their respective classes by the Class Teachers/Subject Teachers.
- f) Attendants and helpers will be on duty at the gate and the corridors.
- g) Students to be seated in their rooms at their respective seats.
- h) All parents to carry authorization pick-up card that is required to be presented at the gate for dispersal. Please get a new card issued from the school office if you don't have the previous one.

4. Safety Measures and Protocol
